

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS UNDER N.R.I CATEGORY AT ANNA UNIVERSITY, TIRUCHIRAPPALLI

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1.1 Application

The application form may be down loaded from the website www.tau.edu.in/nri-adm

1.2 Eligibility and Academic Qualifications

1.2.1 Candidates must have passed (or must be appearing for), the qualifying examination, i.e. (10 + 2) of Indian System or its equivalent for B.E./B.Tech. programmes. For P.G. programmes refer to Anna University website: www.tau.edu.in/nri-adm/elig

1.2.2 B.E./B.Tech. : Candidates must have studied and obtained a pass with Good Grades as per their system of education in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics for all courses including Bio-Technology in the qualifying examination.

PG : Candidates refer to the above website.

1.2.3 Candidates who have studied the subjects in English medium alone will be considered for admission.

1.3. Registration Fee

A Bank Draft for US \$ 200 drawn in favour of “**The Director, (Admissions)**”, Anna University, Tiruchirappalli.

1.4. Last date for Receipt of Applications

Applications completed in all respects should reach “**The Director, (Admissions)**”, Anna University, Tiruchirappalli. – 620 024, India on or before

01st August, 2007 for Under Graduate and Post Graduate Programmes

1.5 Selection of candidates

1.5.1 Selection of the candidates will be done by counselling as per the rank.

1.5.2 **At the time of counselling, the following documents are to be produced (in original except item No.3)**

1. Recent NRI Status certificate of the sponsor issued by the respective embassy with their seal.
2. NRI Bank account pass book of the sponsor.
3. Passport of the sponsor (Attested Xerox Copy)
4. Qualifying Mark list of the candidate; if the grades are produced, Certificates showing equivalent marks to grades should be submitted.
5. Certificate showing the relationship of the sponsor to the candidate.
6. Certificate showing that the candidate has undergone the respective course in English medium.
7. Employment Certificate of the sponsor. In the case of self employment, nature of business, annual income and required proof.

1.6 **Payment of Tuition Fee**

1.6.1 On receipt of the allotment order the candidate has to pay the prescribed fee immediately in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Director, Admissions"

2. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

2.1. **Reporting to the University:**
